

Palmetto Scholars Academy Facebook Group Guidelines

Purpose: Set forth guidelines for participation in the PSA Families and Teachers Facebook group that promote civility and collaboration, and protect the children of the community.

The PSA Families and Teachers Facebook group is a forum for current and prospective PSA parents and students as well as PSA teachers and administrators. It serves our community by providing a place for the school to share announcements and information about upcoming events, to ask questions, and to connect. The Facebook page is a reflection of PSA's unique culture, helping to raise the overall level of community awareness about our school and attract new students as well as talented education professionals.

Remember that many students are participating in this group. Please keep interactions respectful, positive and productive for everyone!

The following guiding principles have been developed to support constructive interaction among participants in the PSA Families and Teachers Facebook group.

Posting Guidelines

1. Information shared in this forum must be in accordance with the [PSA Social Media Guidelines for Students](#). (see related policy)
2. Do not mention students by name unless they are members of the group and engaged in the present discourse.
3. Questions should be composed with respect and consideration.
4. Complaints should first be addressed through the proper channels at the school, allowing the school the opportunity to respond, and clarify the issue if necessary.
5. Any complaint or accusation that includes specific details about individuals, including identifying traits (license plate numbers, descriptions of the person, any part of names, etc), will be removed and the poster will be directed to contact the school with his/her concern.
6. Advertising, spam, chain letters, etc. are prohibited.
7. Posts which deviate significantly from the spirit of these guidelines may be removed if deemed necessary by the PSA Families and Teachers Facebook group administrator, or as directed by the PSA administration.

Membership

1. This is a closed group with membership maintained by the PSA Families and Teachers Facebook group administrator.
2. Parent/guardian permission is sought before PSA students are granted admission to the group. (The preferred process is for parents to use the "Add People to Group" box which will indicate approval to the group administrator.)
3. The group administrator reserves the right to remove members from the group when their association with the school has ended, or when an individual's participation in the group deviates significantly from the Posting Guidelines.
